The Bernese Sitting-Room

This sitting-room was restored in 2014 and contains objects and paintings reminiscent of the Bernese bailiffs. Through the centuries, several coats of paint have been added over the wood panelling. During the restoration, we have tried to recover the oldest coat of paint. This is why the sitting-room went from grey to ochre.
